

Uses: The Dropper Loop creates a loop in the middle of your leader and provides an attachment point for an additional fly. If desired the loop can be made long enough to set a hook directly on it.

Advantages: The Dropper Loop angles away from the line, which helps to avoid tangles.

### Directions:

1. Create a loop in the line.
2. Hold the lines where they cross each other.
3. Wrap the loop over the cross point about 6 to 8 times.
4. Open a hole in the twists where you are holding the line (A match stick can also be used).
5. Pass the loop through this hole.
6. Lubricate the line, hold the loop and pull tight on the knot.
