and or between 8:am - 10:00 am on Sunday the 19th, @ **SanDiego Marlin Club Only.**

Species : Dorado and Yellowtail

Junior Anglers: Fish for free, different prizes.

Guests: All guests may fish 2 tournaments with out being a member as long as they are fishing on a Members boat or have a member with them on their boat.
All persons and guests on every boat must be entered in the tournament.

Tournament Rules : Each angler must weigh one dorado and one yellowtail for a combined weight. The three anglers with the largest combined weight of both species will win 1st, 2nd and 3rd. Place. If nobody catches both species, the winner will be determined by your single largest fish of any species. (either a dorado or yellowtail).

Sports points : You will weigh your two largest fish, it needs to be a Dorado and a Yellowtail (Two fish of both species per angler). The three anglers with the largest two fish will receive sports points 5 points for 1st place, 4 points for 2nd place and 3 points for 3rd place in Mens, Womens and Juniors.

Side Pot : Largest Tuna, **NO Skipjack or Bonita**

Side Pot Cost : \$10.00 All anglers per boat must be entered in the side pot to win...

Weigh Master : (Jim Morgan) Any and all protests must be made at the scale during the weighing of any fish, All ties will go to the angler who weighed in first. Final time is determined by the weigh masters watch. Any questions call Jim @ 619-646-8556
